

Constellation Star

Using the Square in a Square Technique

Size: 25" x 25"

Fabric Requirements:

½ Yard Color #1 Star Points and centers

½ Yard Color #2 Star Points and centers

3/8 yard background

1/3 yard binding

1 yard backing

Before Class, PRECUT the following and label. (no.) is number of strips selvage to selvage:

Color 1:

(1) – 3 3/8" strip into 5 - 3 3/8" squares

(4) – 2" strips (outside border)

(3) – 1.50" strips (star points)

Color 2:

(1) – 3 3/8" strip into 4 - 3 3/8" squares

(4) – 1.50" strips (star points)

(3) – 1 ¼" strips (small inside border)

Background -

(2) – 3 3/8" strips into 16 – 3 3/8" squares, sub-cut remaining strips to 6 - 2 7/8" squares

(1) – 2 ½" strips into 12 – 2 ½" squares

(1) – 2" strips into 12 – 2" x 3 3/8" rectangles

Binding

(3) 2 1/4" strips

Bring the Following with you to Class:

1. Sewing Machine – in good working order, new needle, ¼" seam foot, thread and several bobbins (pre-wound)
2. Rotary cutter, medium sized rotary mat, normal cutting ruler 6 x 24 or 6 x 12 strip cutter.
3. General sewing supplies – small scissors, pins, rippers, etc.
4. Fabric for class project. Strips and squares pre-cut and labeled from cutting directions
5. Square in a Square Ruler (will be available at class if you do not have one)
6. Personal Iron & Board (if you have these)
