12 inch block

## 1. Make Half Square Triangles (HST):

Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of each 5 inch white square.

Place one white 5 inch square on top of one blue square with right sides together. Sew a scant $1 / 4$ inch on either side of the diagonal line.


Cut on the drawn line and press seams to dark side. Trim to measure $41 / 2$ inches square.

2. Sew blocks together (using the $41 / 2$ inch wow) in three rows using all scant $1 / 4$ " seams, as shown below. Press seams in alternating directions by row.


To make a 9 inch block, cut squares to make HST 4 inches, then trim to $31 / 2$ inches square.
To make a 6 inch block, cut squares to make HST 3 inches, then trim to $21 / 2$ inches square.
