Quilts can be up to 144" around the perimeter. That's 36" x 36" but you could make it 5" x 67" or 52" x 24" -- or just 12" x 12". The reveal will be at the September meeting.

Cost to participate is \$5.00. (This pays for the FQ and underwrites the cash prizes.)


UFO Meeting

Color Theory Workshop for Quilters!!



Have you ever asked yourself or someone else, "what colors go well together?" Do you find yourself always choosing the same colors because you "like" them?

Come enjoy a day of no sewing, but learning all about color. We will start the day by mixing colors to paint and create color wheels and value scales, and learn about color theory; primary, secondary, tertiary, analogous, neutrals, warm and cool, monochromatic, tints/shades, complementary, split complimentary, etc. After lunch, participants will create a variety of color schemes, using swatches of fabric, that will work well for future quilts. August 26 - Piecekeeper Project Bag Store and carry all your project pieces or supplies in this handy zippered bag with attached handle.




