

## NLCQG for July 2023 Quilt Guild Bingo

Our July meeting will include our ice cream social, a mystery quilt show and Quilt Guild Bingo! Everyone should make their own Bingo card following the instructions below and bring it along with a selection of buttons to use as markers to the July meeting. Feel free to make more than one card and donate them to the 'I forgot my card!' pile. There will be lots of fun prizes and no one will leave empty handed!

Instructions for making your Quilter's Bingo Card (finished size: 10 1/2"):

You'll need:

- 5 (2 1/2") squares in assorted purples
- 5 (2 1/2") squares in assorted reds
- 5 (2 1/2") squares in assorted yellows
- 5 (2 1/2") squares in assorted blues
- 5 (2 1/2") squares in assorted greens



Each fabric must be from one of the following categories:

Batik	Dot	Floral	Geometric	Heart
Holiday	Leaf	Metallic	Novelty	Paisley
Plaid	Solid	Stripe	1930s print	Star

Your columns will contain fabrics from 1 color and 5 different categories arranged in the order of your choice. Categories may be repeated but NOT within the color column. Each of your squares should represent only one category as Bingo calls will be by color & category (example 'yellow / heart').

### Block Assembly

Join 5 purple squares in different categories to make 1 column.

In the same manner, make 1 red, 1 yellow, 1 blue, and 1 green column.

Join the columns in any any position you choose.

Since these will be handled we ask that you baste 1/8" around the outside of the square to prevent raveling.

If you don't have enough of a fabric scrap variety, feel free to swap fabrics at any of our guild or UFO meetings. All bingo cards will be donated to make charity quilts after the meeting. If you have any questions, contact [president@nlcgg.org](mailto:president@nlcgg.org).
