## Scrappy Squares

$31 \frac{1}{2}^{\prime \prime} \times 40 \frac{1^{\prime \prime}}{}$
This fun little quilt is the perfect size for use with a wheelchair or car seat.

## Fabric Requirements:

43 - assorted 5" squares
(Hint: having a few extra may be helpful when arranging)
Frame \& Binding: 3/4 yd.
(Hint: select a fabric that reads as a solid when using patterned 5" squares)
Backing: $1 \frac{1}{4} \mathrm{yd}$.

Cutting Requirements:
Frame: 4-5" $\times 23^{\prime \prime}$
Binding: 4-2 $\frac{1}{2}^{\prime \prime} \times$ WOF strips

## Construction:

## Center Section

1. Arrange 15 squares ( 5 rows of 3 squares each) in a pleasing manner.
2. Sew squares together into rows. Press.
3. Sew rows together to complete center. Press.

## Frame Center Section

1. Stitch a 5" strip to either side. Press to the frame.
2. Stitch a 5" strip to the top and bottom. Press to the frame.

## Complete Quilt Top

1. Arrange 28 squares in a pleasing manner around the frame section.
2. Stitch the squares, 7 squares on each side, into 2 columns. Press
3. Stitch the squares, 7 squares on top and bottom, into 2 rows. Press.
4. Stitch each column to either side of the frame section. Press.
5. Stitch each row to the top and bottom of the frame section. Press.

## Finishing

Quilt as desired.
Apply binding using your preferred technique.
