Oh Sew Easy Tablerunner

Materials:

1/4 yard focus fabric (center)
1/2 yard coordinating fabric (border/back)
2 buttons (optional)

- 1. Cut focus fabric 9" x WOF. Cut coordinate fabric 18" x WOF (width of fabric) (for mini runner: cut focus 6" x 21" and coordinate 10" x 21")
- 2. Stitch focus fabric to coordinate along the long edge, right sides together, with a 1/2" seam. Repeat on the other long edge.
- Press seams away from focus fabric.
- 4. Turn right-side-out. You will now have a long tube.
- Lay flat on the ironing board and press, so that the focus fabric is bordered evenly on the long sides with the coordinating fabric.
- 6. Trim both of the short ends even, removing selvedge edges.
- 7. Fold the fabric tube in half lengthwise with the focus fabric to the outside, and stitch both ends with a 1/2" seam. (note: this part may not seem right, but it will make sense when you're done)
- 8. Press seams open.
- 9. Turn seams to inside to form a point and press.
- 10. Stitch a button or yo-yo as shown to secure ends. Optional: topstitch on the coordinate fabric, around all four sides of the focus fabric.
